Spring Blooms Mobile Photography (9-13 years) (1½ hr) \$25

Capture Wittunga Botanic Garden's stunning spring display on your own mobile device! Learn about mobile device photography skills, macro photography using a 30x lens attachment (provided), and how to edit your photos using mobile apps while exploring the beautiful Garden. **Please bring your own charged tablet or mobile device. Participants are required to download the free App "Snapseed" to their device prior to the session. Meet inside the Garden next to the carpark at Wittunga Botanic Garden. Bookings Essential.**

Garden Critters (6-12 yrs, 1hr) \$12

Curious botanic bits taken from the Garden such as seedpods and leaves, are there for you to create a cute critter to take home! Due to use of hot glue gun during workshop, parents/carers must work with their children at all times; children under 6yrs cannot be admitted into the activity. **Held in the Lecture Theatre of the Goodman Building at Adelaide Botanic Garden. Bookings Essential.**

Mobiles and Mandalas (5-12yrs) (1 hr) \$12

Take a guided walk through Wittunga Botanic Garden to collect unusual botanic bits, then weave them into a marvellous mobile to take home. Then use natural materials to create a masterpiece mandala – a circular geometric pattern. **Meet inside the Garden next to the carpark at Wittunga Botanic Garden. Bookings Essential.**

Dreaming Story Telling (1hr) FREE

Listen to Aboriginal Dreaming stories and understand what they can teach us about life. Learn how to identify tracks and traces in the environment. **Held in the Lecture Theatre of the Goodman Building at Adelaide Botanic Garden. No bookings required.**

Making Fire, Making Glue (1hr) FREE

Learn how Aboriginal people make fire using just what is around them in the Australian bush. How they make glue from plants! **Meet on the Schomburgk Pavilion unless it's raining, in which case it will be held in the Lecture Theatre of the Goodman Building. No bookings required.**
