Belair National Park – Gold Escort Park (near Adventure Playground)

School start - normal time (Travel by train in class groups)

This year's event will be at the '**Gold Escort**' park, which is closer to Government House and State Flora). You will not be required to pay an entry fee as we have a booking. Please mention Eden Hills PS at the gate if asked.

Students will need to bring a school hat, sunblock, recess, lunch and a drink to school.

The walk from Belair Station is slightly longer than the trek to the park booked in previous years. However, staff and children were keen to spend time at the Adventure Playground, and there is plenty of space there for nature play, which was also very popular last year.

- Options for a walk to the lower waterfall (return 60-90 minutes with steep sections)
- A short walk to Echo Tunnel could be an option for middle primary children
