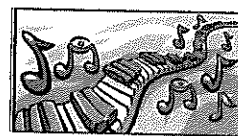

Mitcham Hills Eisteddfod

I would like to invite all students at Eden Hills Primary who learn music to participate in the mini Eisteddfod which I have been holding for the last twelve years. This year it will be held in **Ashby Hall** at Blackwood Primary School **on Sunday 25th August from 1pm** for all the children who learn an instrument (including voice), whether during school hours or out of school. The event has been very successful in previous years with over 50 children competing each time. I would encourage as many students as possible to enter and have a go; it's good fun and a great experience.

Every participant needs to fill out the entry form attached, stating which class they are entering for. This needs to be signed by a parent or carer, and by the music teacher, if lessons are held out of school. Every participant will receive a certificate of participation and some verbal words of encouragement from an independent adjudicator. There will be one winner per class who will receive a winner's certificate and a prize. There will be a cost involved of \$5 per person (regardless of how many classes you enter) to cover the cost of certificates, prizes and a thank you gift for the adjudicator.

The classes will be assigned approximate starting times once all entries are in, so there is no need for everyone to be there all afternoon if you have other commitments. The multipurpose room will be used for instruments to warm up beforehand. I will be there all afternoon, and tea, coffee, soft drinks and snacks will be on offer throughout the afternoon at a small cost. The Rotary Club of Glenelg offers a BBQ and Winston Music will again sponsor the Eisteddfod, providing the loan of an upright piano for the event free of charge and vouchers as prizes.

The aim is to provide an element of competition for all ages and levels in a safe and fun environment.

ROTARY places great value on all human life, so \$1 per entry this year will be donated towards Shelterbox Australia: providing emergency shelter and aid to families affected by natural disaster and humanitarian crisis.

This will be the 13th year for the Eisteddfod so let's make it a successful one.
